**OPERATIONAL AGREEMENT
ON EDUCATION COOPERATION
BETWEEN THE
MINISTRY OF EDUCATION of ARUBA
AND SENECA COLLEGE of CANADA**

The Ministry of Education of Aruba and Seneca College, Ontario, Canada hereinafter referred to as the Signatories;

Having signed an MOU on October 8 in Toronto to foster a friendly relationship, establish a mutually beneficial relationship through education and exchange of knowledge, and to stimulate student mobility between countries;

Believing that the geopolitical position of Aruba, unique socio-economic resources, and national commitment to sustainable economic growth through renewable energy provides valuable learning and research opportunities for both Signatories;

Considering that Seneca College is a leader in the field of higher education, providing high-quality programs and career preparation, with a global perspective, alongside a commitment to their community;

Are now signing an operational agreement with the following details:

PARAGRAPH I: Tuition fee discount

The Signatories agree to special fees according to the following principles:

A. The students from Aruba who are eligible for this fee may make use of the government loan for study abroad.

B. Aruban students will receive a deep discount of 30 % on the academic fees for international students as published each year on Seneca's website. The application process for the students is the same as for any other international students, but they will be given a certain code to be included in the application form which will process the discount.

PARAGRAPH II: Trades program for green energy maintenance

In the light of Aruba's plan to become "carbon neutral" the Parties intend to:

1. Explore closer relationships between Seneca College, the country of Aruba, University of Aruba, secondary and other post-secondary institutions, appropriate educational organizations, economic organizations, and private sector establishments involved in education to deliver a specialized certificate program in maintenance of the refurbished technology in Aruba.
2. Provide further education for a limited amount of graduates from such a program as technicians in Seneca's two year diploma program and/or as technologists in Seneca's three year advanced diploma program in Toronto.
3. Pricing for these customized programs will be established between Seneca and parties wishing to pursue training opportunities.


The cooperation outlined in this Operational Agreement is to commence upon the date of signature.
